Fuel supplements, government fees and taxes, shore excursions, medical services, items of a personal nature such as bar beverages, gift shop purchases, beauty salon/barber shop and massage services, gambling and service/porterage gratuities - are not included in the cruise rate. Carnival reserves the right to reinstate the fuel supplement for all guests at up to \$9 per guest per day if the NYMEX oil price exceeds \$70 per barrel. The amount of fuel supplements and government fees and taxes is subject to change, and Carnival reserves the right to pass through to guests (including fully paid and deposited guests) any increases in such items. "Fuel supplements" shall mean any additional charge to defray a portion of Carnival's fuel costs.
