ABOUT THE ITINERARY

The most northerly of the Ionian island, **Corfu** is the closest to both Italy in the west and Albania in the east; it has been touched over the years by several other foreign cultures. The Greek name for the island is Kerkira, the name Corfu is an Italian version of the ancient Greek word koryphai, meaning "the hills", referring to the two elevated spots in Corfu town where Old and New Fortresses were founded. The Venetians had the most impact on Corfu, culturally and big enough

to provide escape from the crowds into untouched mountain villages.

Santorini's spectacular caldera is a vestige of what was probably the biggest volcanic eruption in recorded history, believed by some to have caused the disappearance of Atlantis. The island's violent volcanic history is visible everywhere you look - in black-sand beaches, earthquake-damaged dwellings and raw cliffs of lava plunging into the sea.





Katakolo (<u>Greek</u>: Κατάκολο) is a seaside town in the municipality of <u>Pyrgos</u> in western <u>Elis</u>, <u>Greece</u>. The port of Katakolo is a popular stop for <u>cruise ships</u>, offering an opportunity for passengers to visit the site of <u>Ancient Olympia</u>. Low hills with forests surround Katakolo. The lighthouse of Katakolo was built in 1865. One of the most important sites of Katakolo is the <u>Museum of Ancient Greek Technology</u>.

The Museum of the Ancient Greek Technology revives 350 amazing inventions of the ancient Greeks (from the robot - servant of Philon to the "cinema" of Heron and from the hydraulic clock of Archimedes to the analog computer of Antikythera) covering the period from 2000 B.C. up to the end of the ancient Greek world. It is the most authoritative and complete exhibition of its kind in the world.
