

Day 1: Wednesday, June 10, 2015 Jackson, Wyoming - Tour Begins Arrive in Jackson, America's most famous cowboy town

Day 2: Thursday, June 11, 2015 Jackson This morning the choice is yours. Enjoy a relaxing wildlife float trip or an exciting whitewater rafting adventure! Both paths take you along the Snake River and offer up dramatic views of a grand landscape complete with a picnic lunch. The rest of the afternoon is yours to experience all that Jackson has to offer. Tonight catch the spirit of this rollicking town with some funfilled cowboy entertainment at the Jackson Hole Rodeo*. Day 3: Friday, June 12, 2015 Jackson - Grand Tetons -

Yellowstone Wind through Grand
Teton National Park, home to the
youngest peaks in the Rockies. Keep
your camera ready. There are plenty
of opportunities to take photos. Next,
visit incomparable Yellowstone
National Park, the first and oldest
national park in the world.

Yellowstone, a true symbol of the west, stretches across 3,470 square miles and touches three western states. Famous for its geysers, hot springs and incredible wildlife – including free-ranging herds of buffalo – Yellowstone lives up to its reputation. A park ranger joins your group to discuss the past, present and future of the park as you observe the unspoiled natural splendor. Of course, no visit to Yellowstone would be complete





without seeing its most famous attraction: Old Faithful. Watch in amazement as the geyser erupts, sending a fountain of steam more than 60 feet in the air! (*B*, *D*)

Day 4: Saturday, June 13, 2015 Yellowstone - Cody -

Sheridan Begin your day with a journey along Lake Yellowstone and over Sylvan Pass. From the mountains to the prairies, the scenery is simply astounding. Pass through Cody and visit the Buffalo Bill Historical Center – a tribute to one of the most colorful figures of the Old West. Before turning in for the night in Sheridan, make your way through the incredible Bighorn Mountains and cross through the territory of the Great Sioux Nation. (*B*)

Day 5: Sunday, June 14, 2015 Sheridan - Deadwood - Rapid City, South Dakota En route to

Rapid City, stop in Deadwood, a rowdy, rambling western town that has been named a national historic landmark. Recreations of turn-of-thecentury street lamps light the way

through the restored architecture. A local guide introduces you to the history of the city, including a visit to Mount Moriah Cemetery, final resting place of Wild Bill Hickok, Calamity Jane and other figures of the Wild West. Enjoy some time to ramble through Deadwood where gold, gambling and gunpowder were once the order of the day. The adventure continues this afternoon when you visit Lead's visitor center where you will hear the story of the famous Black Hills Gold Rush and how this city played such an important role in South Dakota's history. Day 6: Monday, June 15, 2015 Rapid City - Crazy Horse -

Rapid City Today, learn more about this diverse region. Jump into the world of Black Hills gold on a tour through the Mt. Rushmore Black Hills Gold and Diamond Factory. See skilled artisans handcraft South Dakota's official state jewelry. Then, visit Prairie Edge, a Plains Indian store and museum filled with native art, crafts and jewelry. Created by hand, their work remains faithful to

the Plains Indian spirit and tradition.

Next, prepare to be amazed by the
Crazy Horse Memorial, the world's
largest sculpture still in progress. The
memorial includes the Indian Museum
of North America, Native American
Cultural Center, the sculptor's studio,
an orientation center and theaters.

Many Native American artists and
craftspeople practice their art at the
memorial and are on hand to discuss
the influence their culture has on their
work. This evening's dinner is a
special treat: enjoy a Jeep ride
followed by a traditional Chuckwagon


