Day 1: Sunday, November 10, 2013



The remainder of your day is at leisure to independently explore this unparalleled city. Day 7: Saturday, November 16, 2013

Pisa & Lucca Tour

The famous Leaning Tower of Pisa is just one of many reasons to visit the ancient maritime Republic of Pisa. This day tour begins with a trip to this famous town. Pisa's Piazza del Duomo, also known as Piazza dei Miracoli ("Field of Miracles") has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage site. Here you'll find the Duomo, the world-famous Leaning Tower, the historic Baptistery and the Camposanto. A local guide will accompany your visit to the cathedral and baptistery. Enjoy free time to shop before heading to Lucca, an ancient city with Etruscan roots. Known for its Renaissance-era city walls, Lucca achieved prosperity through the silk trade. Enjoy a walking tour with a local expert and view the 14th century Cathedral of San Martino, Lucca's medieval streets, Piazza S. Michele in Foro and Piazza Napoleone. You will also get the opportunity to appreciate the amazingly intact 16th-century walls built to defend the town. Enjoy free time to discover your own treasures before returning to Montecatini.

Admission to the Cathedral and Baptistery of Pisa are included. Private round trip transportation is also included. Please note that it may not be possible to visit the inside of the Cathedral of San Martino in Lucca during scheduled Sunday masses. Rome

The Vatican Museums and St. Peter's Basilica

The Vatican Museums are not only home to one of the world's greatest collections of art, but also to the world-famous Sistine Chapel. Priceless artifacts from ancient Egypt, Etruscan Italy and cultures around the world are preserved in the Vatican's palaces, galleries, halls, and rooms. Other walls feature paintings by Pietro Perugino, Sandro Botticelli, Cosimo Rosselli, and Domenico Ghirlandaio. Your final stop will be at St. Peter's Basilica, one of the most important churches in Christendom, and until recently, the largest in the world. Price includes admission and the use of headphones inside the museum. It is highly recommended to book this optional tour in advance of your tour departure. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required.
